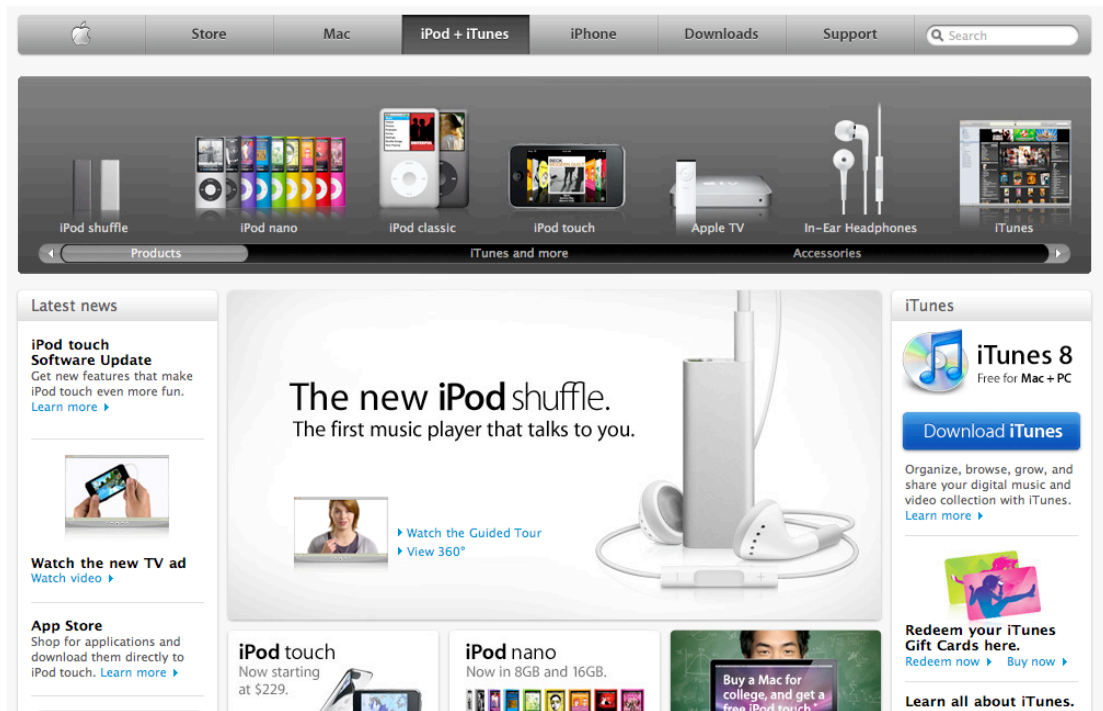


# iPhonew Zealand

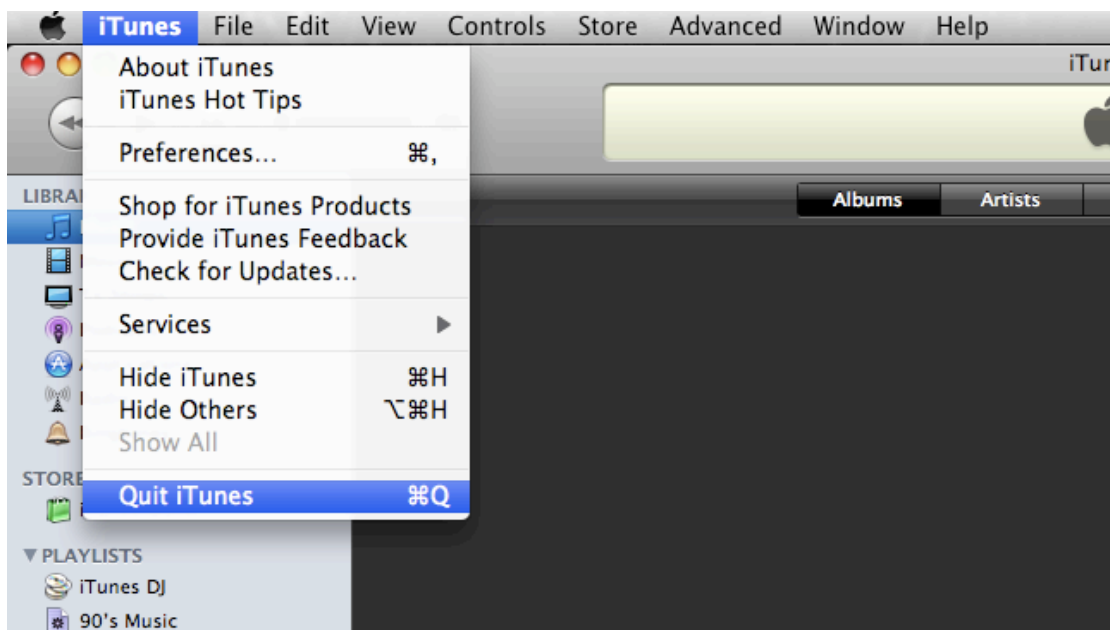
How to get your iPhone to work on your chosen provider network in 6 easy steps:

Install the latest version of iTunes from <http://www.apple.com/itunes/>

Click the blue 'Download iTunes' button



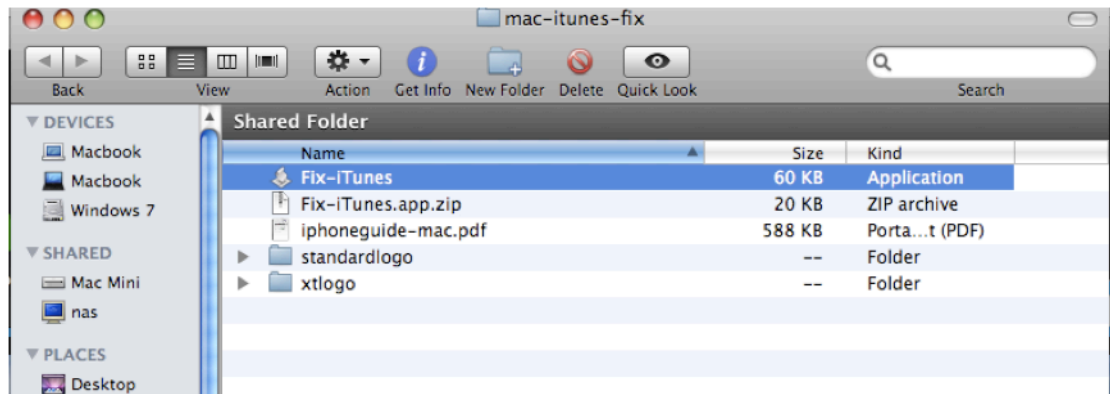
After iTunes is installed launch the application and then quit iTunes.



If you have not done so already, download the following file and extract the zip to your desktop:

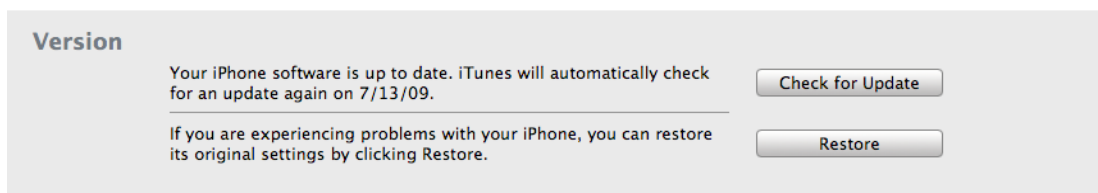

Double Click the “Fix-iTunes.app.zip” In the main folder then double click the extracted file “Fix-iTunes”

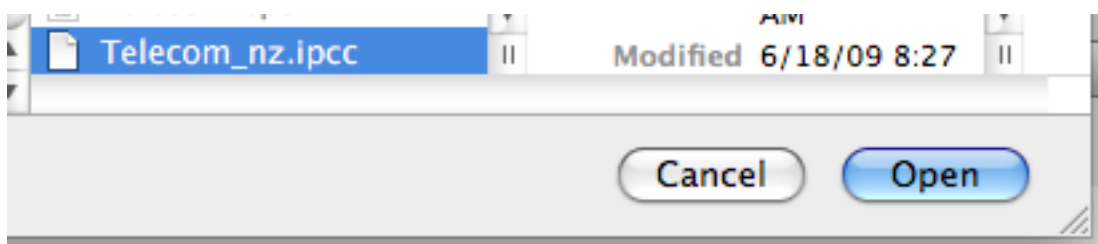


This will automatically open terminal, run the command and then close it again. You may not see terminal open, only the Applescript icon appear and then disappear in the dock. This is normal and means the fix has been applied.

Start iTunes – connect your iPhone – When iTunes sees your iPhone press and hold the ‘Option’ key on the keyboard while clicking the “check for update” button.



Select the Carrier bundle (.ipcc file) you would like to install from the folder you just downloaded.



Once this file has been loaded into your iPhone all required settings for your carrier would have been added to your iPhone.

Simply restart your phone by holding the silver button on the top of your iPhone to turn the device off and then on.
